Dear Friend of Khor Wakow Project,

As we reflect on *all of the changes being accomplished* in the Khor Wakow region of South Sudan, we want to take time to thank you for your support of this work. Your support is directly impacting the lives of over 2,100 children who are now able to attend school every day in a country experiencing the horrors of war-- starvation, displacement, and continual unrest.

This year the Khor Wakow Project added four additional school sites-- growing educational services to seven of the twelve villages along the Khor Wakow River. We provide academic materials, teachers, and work collaboratively with community members to build simple school structures at each site that allow students to have school without disruption from the elements.

Women in the communities are learning to read for the first time in history in a new after school program for women. Women are also being encouraged to address needs in the community directly impacting the lives of their children through collaboration. We are now providing agricultural training for farmers and Biblical training for pastors. In the coming year, we are working to develop and expand health services to the villages as healthcare is non-existent in the region.

It is *people like you that have made it possible* to accomplish our *mission of supporting Christ-centered education, health, and humanitarian efforts to the people of the Khor Wakow region and empowering its community to identify and pursue improvements that will enhance all aspects of their lives.*
